

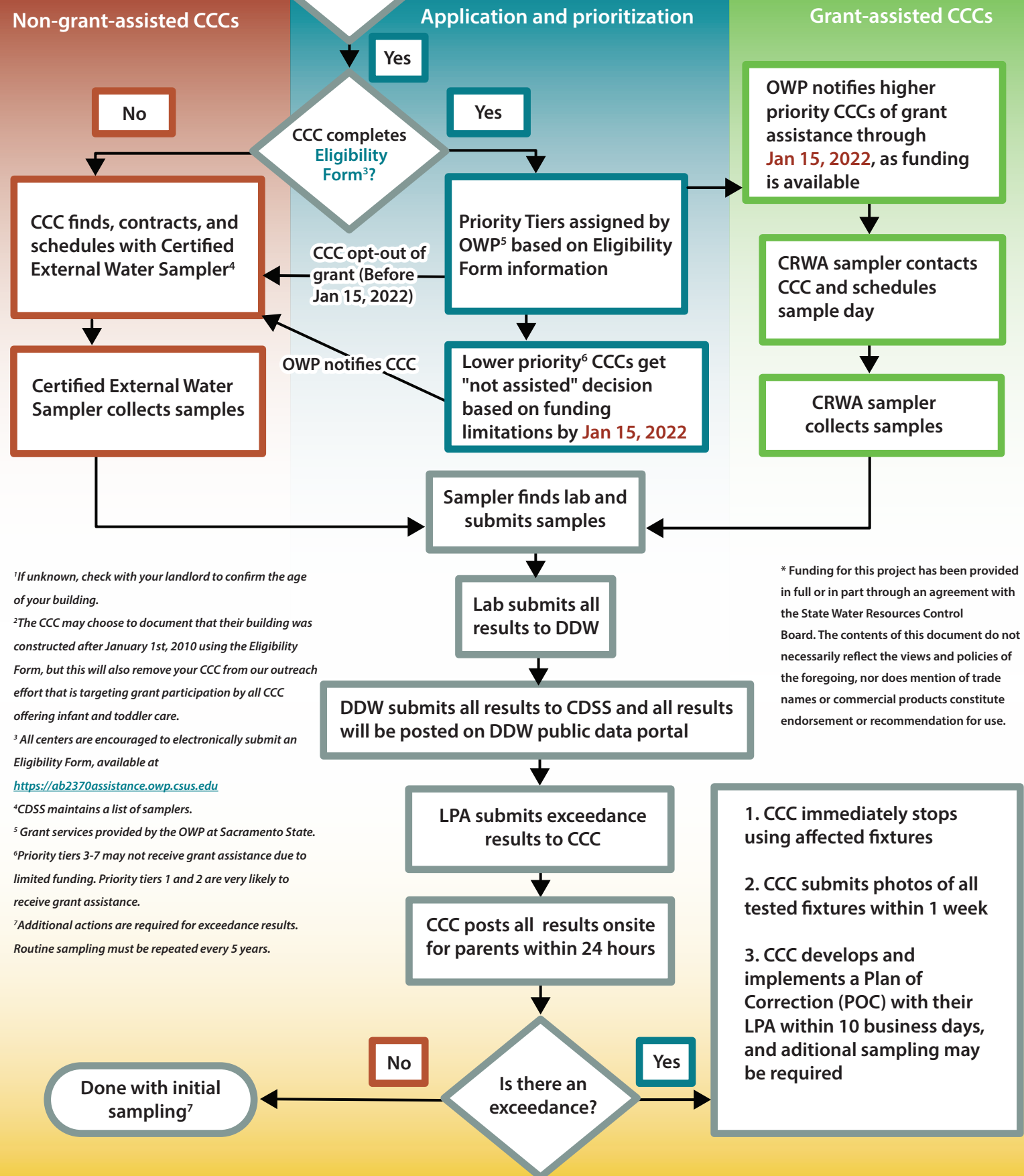

<sup>2</sup>The CCC may choose to document that their building was constructed after January 1st, 2010 using the Eligibility Form, but this will also remove your CCC from our outreach effort that is targeting grant participation by all CCC offering infant and toddler care.

1. CCC immediately stops using affected fixtures
2. CCC submits photos of all tested fixtures within 1 week
3. CCC develops and implements a Plan of Correction (POC) with their LPA within 10 business days, and additional sampling may be required
